

GENERAL SITE RULES FOR VISITORS (INCL. SUBCONTRACTORS & MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC)

It is important to remember this is an operational site. The following are general rules that you **must** follow during your visit.

Upon your arrival you will be required to sign in at Reception, using the visitor's book, where you will be met by an appropriate member of staff, who will accompany you on site. Please remember to sign out in the visitor's book before leaving the premises.

If you are going onto the operational site you are required to wear a safety hat, high visibility jacket/waistcoat and suitable safety shoes.

Whilst the use of mobile phones is permitted on the site, it is requested that you consider all Health and Safety issues, such as personal concentration whilst doing so.

All warning signs must be adhered to and any requests made by members of staff, in relation to Health and Safety matters, complied with.

Any visitors to the Washing Plant with any active body implant such as Heart Pace Maker or Insulin Pump must be aware of the potential for such devices to become affected by the **electromagnetic field** surrounding the magnet and it is recommended that visitors with such devices avoid accessing the plant altogether. A full presentation of the Washing Plant can be viewed in the conference room as an alternative.

Ear defenders are a compulsory requirement and must be worn at all times during the washing plant visit. Safety goggles may be worn if you chose.

Please be reminded that this is an operational site with a high volume of vehicle movements and to ensure your safety and the safety of others, always be aware of moving vehicles.
